

Email sent to Intellisync Users 4/1/2008

Hello,

This email is to inform you that after the MeetingMaker upgrade on April 26-27, 2008, MeetingMaker will no longer support the use of Intellisync to convert or sync calendar data to Outlook or a Windows OS handheld. In response to this discontinuation of support, AHC IS will be offering wireless syncing services for those who wish to sync their calendar and/or email with their PDA.

This option is available only to those users who use a PDA that has either wireless or data package connectivity. In this scenario, data from MeetingMaker (and/or U of M email) is sent directly over a wireless connection to a NotifyLink server to the users handheld. Users do not need to cradle-sync their device to get calendar (and/or email) data. This option requires the user to pay a one-time \$125.00 license fee.

It is important to note that if you do nothing, syncing with Intellisync will cease to work on April 28th. Use of NotifyLink is entirely optional. AHC IS will provide directions, user ids, and passwords. There are many ways handheld devices can be configured and we expect that you know best how to operate your device and would expect you to configure and understand the subtleties of how changing settings may impact your data.
